Space Operations Organization (SpaceOps) is pleased to announce its **2023 Space Operations Awards**. These awards recognize the most eminent persons and teams with exceptional merit in all aspects of space operations who have made fundamental and global impacts upon the world's progress in space explorations.

The Call for Nominations for the 2023 Space Operations Awards are addressed to world space agencies, SpaceOps members and member organisations in good standing and SpaceOps officers and chairpersons of the SpaceOps technical and administrative committees.

Nominations should contain:

- A short citation of the exceptional merits (5 lines maximum);
- A justification specifying the impact of the merits to the progress of space activities on a global scale (no more than 2 pages);
- An additional information about the nominee including, i.e. the nominee's profile, career achievements and history, education, list of publications, etc.;
- At least 3 letters of support by international personalities qualified to nominate and addressing the contributions of the nominee.

During the SpaceOps Fall Meetings in August 2022, the **SpaceOps Awards Committee** will make recommendation for the recipients to the awards. The **SpaceOps Executive Committee** will make final determination of award recipients at the same meetings.

The SpaceOps Award recipients will be inducted during the Closing Ceremony of the 2023 SpaceOps Conference in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.

Nomination documents must be received by SpaceOps Organizations Secretariat by **[29 July 2022 15:00 CET](#)**.
